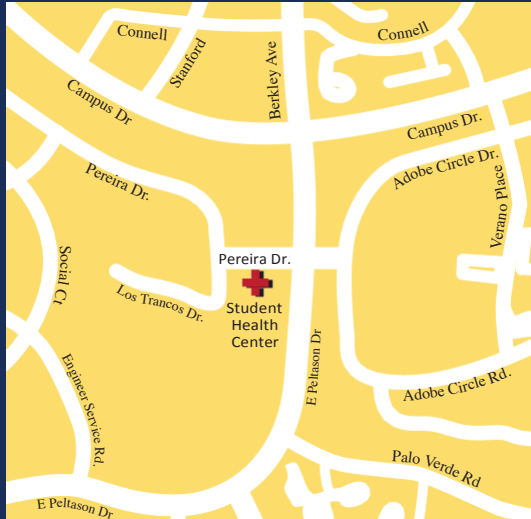


How to Get to the Student Health Center

What Is the UC Irvine Student Health Center?

- The Student Health Center is a comprehensive outpatient clinic staffed with licensed, board certified physicians, dentists, physician assistants, certified nurse practitioners, registered nurses and other practitioners.
- Services are available to all UC Irvine Registered Students and Continuing Education Students.

What Services are Offered at Student Health?

General Primary Care Clinic

Monday - Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm

Comprehensive primary health care services for students are offered at affordable rates. Log on to the secure Student Health Portal at <https://osh.shs.uci.edu/> to make an appointment online or call (949) 824-5304. A limited number of walk-in appointments are available each day for more urgent problems. Hours of operation are subject to change.

Psychiatric Services

- Evaluation and treatment of learning, mood, anxiety, thought, eating and developmental disorders, and other mental health conditions.
- Psychiatric consultation, diagnosis, treatment, and follow up.
- Students transferring their care are encouraged to have all prior records sent before their first appointment.

Other Services

Dental Clinic

- Full and comprehensive dental services including exams, digital X-rays, intra-oral camera, tooth whitening, silver – and tooth-colored fillings, porcelain crowns, bridges, guards, and tooth removal.
- The Dental Clinic is a Delta Dental PPO network provider.

Pharmacy

Prescriptions written by Student Health providers or personal physicians may be filled at the Student Health Pharmacy.

Our Pharmacy may contract with your insurance plan. For information regarding prescriptions, pricing or insurance coverage for medications, please call **(949) 824-5923**.

Did You Know...

You can log onto the secure Student Health Portal at <https://osh.shs.uci.edu/> to access various services including: scheduling appointments; completing pre-visit questionnaires/consents; requesting STI testing, birth control medication, health clearances, and medication refills; sending secure messages to your provider; uploading your immunization and TB screening/testing information; and more.

What About Insurance?

As mandated by the UC Regents, the University requires that all students have medical insurance and provides the UC Student Health Insurance Plan (UC SHIP) to meet this requirement. Students participate annually in the evaluation and selection of health insurance plans and benefits through their representatives. UC SHIP offers a comprehensive package of medical, behavioral health, dental, vision and pharmacy benefits that is convenient, affordable and covers the student year-round anywhere in the world. Students are automatically enrolled in the plan and assessed the UC SHIP fees through their campus billing account ("ZOT" account). Students can choose to keep UC SHIP, or waive enrollment if they have coverage that meets "waiver criteria" established by the University. UC SHIP fees, plan benefits, instructions for requesting a waiver, waiver deadlines and other important information is available on the Student Health Center (SHC) website at <https://shc.uci.edu/>.

The SHC is the primary care facility for students covered by UC SHIP. Under this plan, all medical care must be initiated at the SHC. If SHC does not provide a specific medical specialty or service, you will be referred to an in-network provider in the community.

If you are covered by UC SHIP, the cost of your office visits and other medical services will be billed directly to the UC SHIP insurance carriers. After UC SHIP has paid its portion, the amount of co-pays and/or coinsurance that you are responsible for will be billed to your campus billing account ("ZOT" account).

For Non-SHIP registered students, the cost of your office visits and other medical services will be billed directly to your "ZOT" account. SHC does not bill 3rd party insurance other than the UC SHIP plans. SHC can provide you with an itemized receipt that you can submit to your insurance carrier to seek reimbursement.
